➔ Fund Overview

The Denzel Downs Wind Farm is committed to providing a Community Benefit Fund for good causes local to the Wind Farm. The Fund has an annual value of around **£4,500**.

- Grants from £250 to £4,000
- Closing date: 25 March 2026
- Final decisions: by End May 2026

Projects must be within the Parish boundaries of the **Cornwall Council Electoral Division of St Issey and St Tudy**. Priority will be given to applications from the Parishes of St Ervan, St Eval and St Issey in order that the communities closest to the wind farm development will benefit.

➔ Project purpose

The Fund is open to any community project which is for the benefit of residents of the local area. This Fund can provide both capital and revenue grants.

➔ Who can apply?

Eligible organisations include:

- Charities / voluntary, community groups
- The Town and Parish Council
- Schools and educational establishments
- Social enterprises and Community Interest Companies operating on a non-profit-distributing basis.

➔ Who Decides the Grant Allocations?

Applications are reviewed by a local judging panel who make recommendations on which applications received are supported.
